All 4-H Exhibitors will be judged in age appropriate classes using the following categories.

- Cloverbuds, formerly Primary, up to grade 3.
- Junior, grades 3-5 inclusive
- Intermediate, grades 6-8 inclusive
- Senior, grades 9-12 inclusive
